How This Gets Done

- PM and MMs identify target leagues, tournaments and events to activate, focusing on youth program demographics that align with Greenlight audience.
 - PM and MMs will work with each program to ensure optimal site, timing and to ensure Greenlight's involvement is a positive contribution to the event
 - □ Games to be selected on activity (travel team, club sport, academic), location, attendance (age of participants, number of participants) and ability for premium partnership
 - Display will include brightly branded elements to catch the eye and open tent to allow parents' curiosity to be piqued, interactive elements to engage visitors with Greenlight
- Design and produce footprint for indoor and outdoor iterations
 - Design and produce branded giveaway items
 - Use modular footprint elements, with opportunities for experiencing popular and new app features and an insider preview of the benefits of Greenlight for kids and parents.
